The ceremony will be outside—hopefully under blue skies— and dinner and dancing under cover of a tent. Daytime summer temperature on Orcas Island is usually in the seventies (°F), but we recommend bringing a warm layer for the evening.

Directions by car from Seattle: Travel approximately 60 miles north on I-5. Take Exit 230 (just north of Mt. Vernon) and head west on Highway 20. Travel to, and through, downtown Anacortes (about 25 miles) and watch for the green Washington State Ferry terminal signs.

Summer and weekend ferries can be crowded, so arrive well in advance of your intended boarding time. Car pooling with other wedding guests is great idea. If you choose to walk on the ferry, Orcas Island offers shuttle and taxi services. The crossing takes approximately one hour.

Upon arrival on Orcas, turn left at the top of the ferry ramp and follow Orcas Road for about 10 miles to Eastsound. Turn right onto Main Street and pass through Eastsound. Take another right at the dead end onto Olga Road. Inn at Ship Bay is on your right approximately 1/2 mile down Olga Road, going toward Moran State Park.

To get to Moran State Park for Friday night's barbecue, continue on Olga Road until you see the entrance to the park. Follow signs to the Cascade Lake swim area.

For those preferring to fly to Orcas Island, Kenmore Air Floatplanes provides float plane service into Rosario Resort, (800) 543-9595; and San Juan Airlines provides fixed-wheel airplane service into Eastsound Airport, (800) 874-4434.
